Splinter Cell Blacklist has you playing the role of the greatest spy in the world (played by Mike Ironside). You'll sneak behind enemy lines and take out specific targets, or maybe just blow up an entire base with C4. The mission variety in the game is pretty robust for a Splinter Cell title. I'm having fun with it, but I'm not sure if this is my favorite title in the series (that honor may still go to Chaos Theory). There are plenty of gamers out there that have commented that they are sick of playing as Sam Fisher. It seems that some people have said that this game's story is lacking somehow. I don't think the story is bad, but it's not as good as previous titles. The terrorist-themed story seems a little tired to me, but I'm still enjoying the gameplay and action enough to really enjoy this title. Splinter Cell: Blacklist was developed by Ubisoft and published by Ubisoft for PC, Xbox 360, PlayStation 3 and Wii U. A version for Wii U was released on August 20, 2013 in North America and August 23, 2013 in Europe. A version for PlayStation 4 was released on November 19, 2013 in Europe and November 20, 2013 in North America. Another version for Microsoft Windows and OS X was released on September 25, 2014. Wii U version removed from Steam's database in August, 2016. The Xbox 360 and PlayStation 3 versions were delisted from the digital stores on June 2, 2014. The Wii U version received "generally favorable" reviews, while the PC and Xbox 360 versions received "mixed or average reviews", according to video game review aggregator Metacritic.

The following downloadable content packs have been released for the Wii U version of "Splinter Cell Blacklist":

On November 21, 2015 Ubisoft announced an upcoming DLC entitled "Sam Fisher's Ghost Recon Wildlands". A new downloadable content pack, "", is also in development for 2017 and will be released in spring 2017.

On September 25, 2014 Ubisoft announced downloadable content (DLC) for "". The first one was released on November 12, 2014; it was the last DLC pack before the delisting of all console versions of the game. The second one is scheduled to be released on June 3rd 2015 and it's called "Conviction ". The add-ons add new missions and features, such as a new single player campaign, additional weapons and gadgets; vehicles such as motorcycles and boats; cloned enemies; multiplayer maps; mini-games and a challenge mode.
